She's closing it out as Class President.

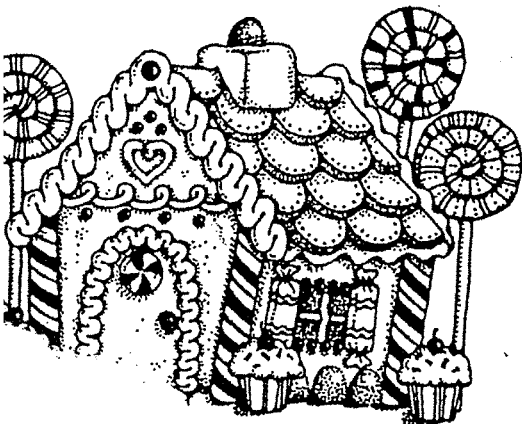
She is top of her class in other ways too.

Is the last big assignment of finding a wife.

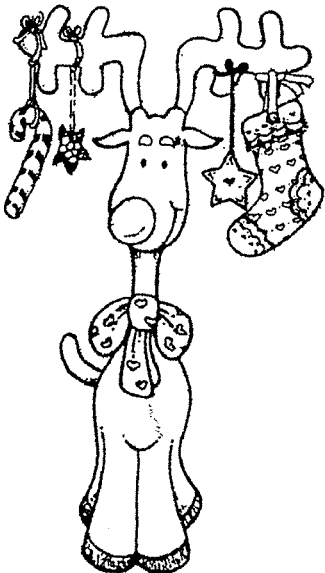
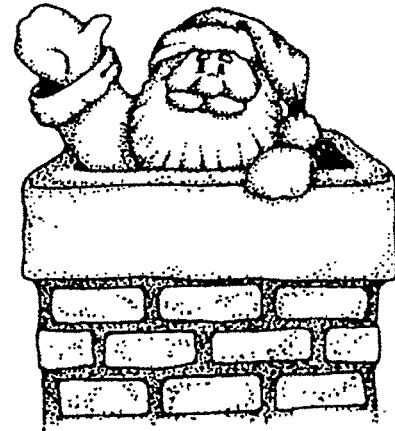
Matt is the skier of the family.
