Three under seven makes a day seem like a year.

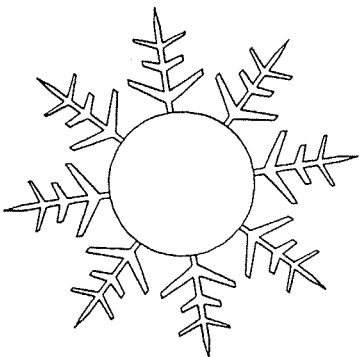
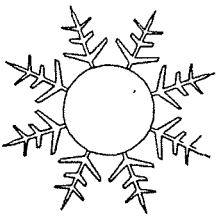
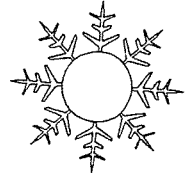
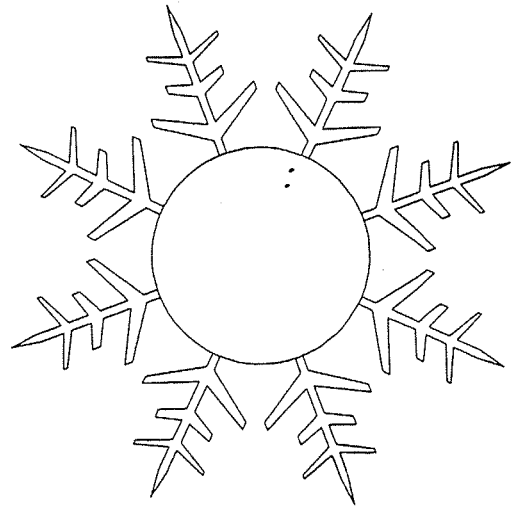
Mitch is now in school is in Grade Number One.

So even with boy's gone she keeps up the commotion.

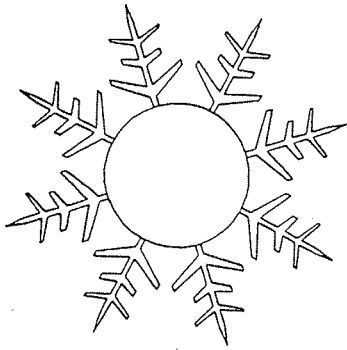
Scott's back into scouting, this time for the Stake.

 Which really can't happen if it doesn't get damp.

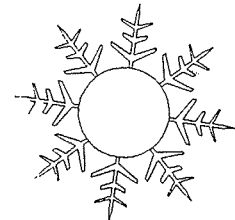
For Jackie and John the best of the year
